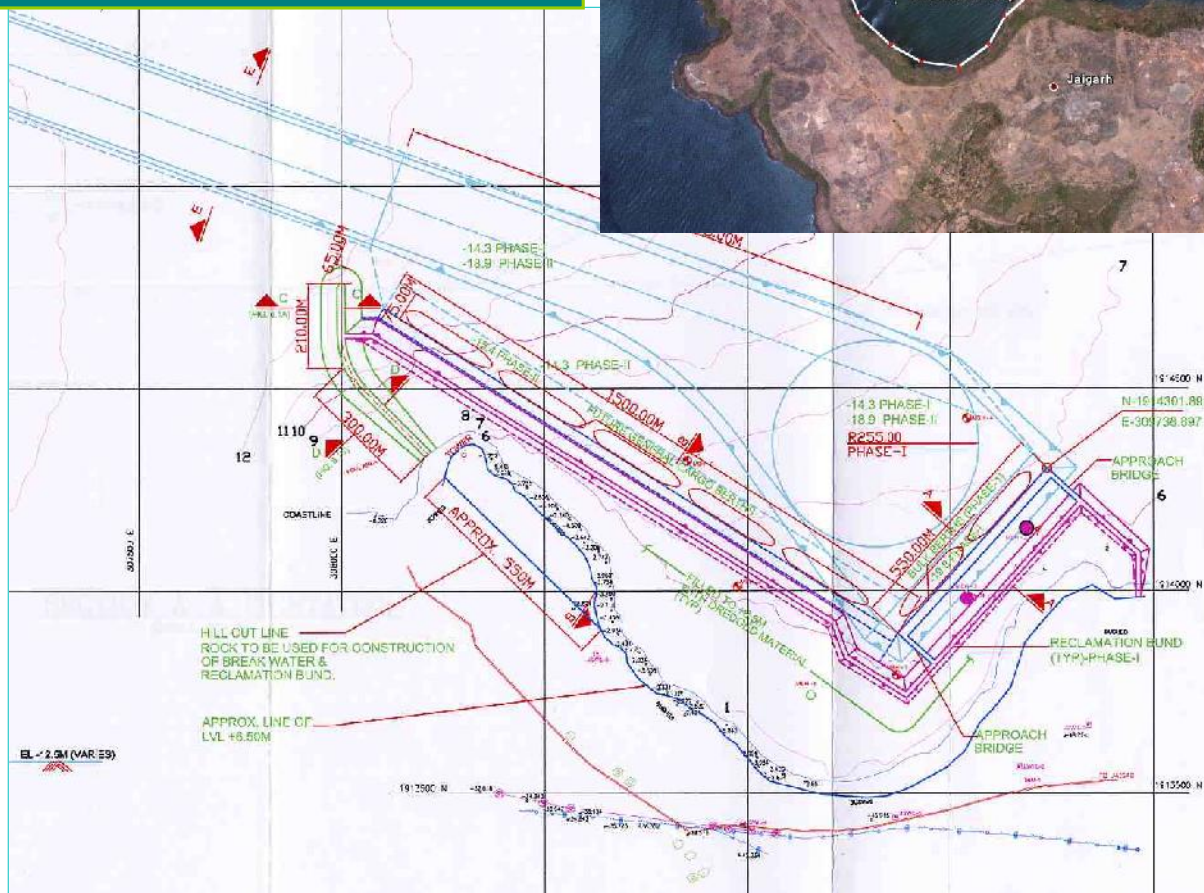




**PROJECT:** GREENFIELD PORT

Jaigarh, in Ratnagiri District of Maharashtra, is the site for a Greenfield Port being developed by **JSW Infrastructure & Logistics Ltd. of JINDAL Group**.

The site is located at Damankul Bay, lies between latitudes 17° 18' 00" and 17° 18' 18" North and 73° 12' and 73° 13' East.

The port is planned taking advantage of the lee of the projected headland with additional projections by means of a breakwater.

Seven berths with a total quay length of 2050 m and a back-up area of 34 Hectares have been planned to provide modern facilities for

- Bulk Terminal for Coal import
- Container Terminal
- Multipurpose Cargo Handling
- Petrochemicals and other Liquids

The port is planned mainly for facilitating support to port-based Power Plant of JINDAL Group and Industries.

- Design and Detailed Engineering Services for Phase I requirements like the Coal Terminal for the Power Plant and General Cargo;
